- After you've developed these comprehensive programs, you'll get to see it all in action – you'll be leading the programs you helped create at locations throughout Alberta during the months of July and August.

### *4-H Camp Staff - Two Month Position*

- You'll be working for the months of July and August at our camps and programs with our four-month 4-H Camp Staff
- NLS certification is a bonus (we have three designated lifeguarding positions)

- If you're applying as a lifeguard, you must possess your NLS certification.
