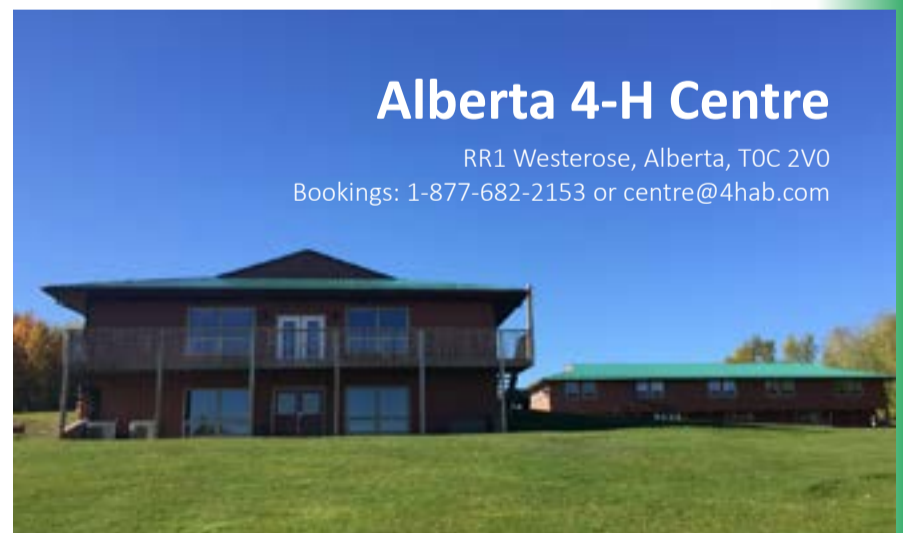
Finally in August, we will be incorporating more outdoor lights around the dorm and lodge making it easier for guests when participating in evening games and activities.

**Coming from Calgary** - Head North on AB-2 for approximately 225KM; take exit 482B onto Ab-13 W for approximately 37KM. Your destination will be on the right

Moose Lake Camp is located on Moose Lake, the Provincial park, at Moose Lake Pentecostal Church Camp – 61025 Range Road 74

**Coming from Bonnyville** – Head to Highway 660 W for ~22km, turn south onto Range Road 74. proceed onto Range Road 73A and follow signs for the Camp

### Pick Up/Drop Off Times:

Campers can get very anxious if they are not picked up with other campers. If you are delayed more than 10 minutes, please call the camp as soon as possible so that a message can be given to your camper and the camp directors. If you are going to be dropping off your camper late, please call the camp to let them know of your approximate arrival time. You must sign in and sign out your campers when dropping them off and picking them up. When you arrive, please park your car and come inside the registration area to sign our forms. A counsellor will escort your child to their room and play get-to-know you games with them.

### Packing List:

We recommend that you do not send campers with expensive clothing or belongings. We would encourage you to check out some second-hand stores for clothes that campers don't mind getting paint/dirt on. To limit the amount of Lost and Found items, we would recommend that their names be written on the tag of their clothing in sharpie (for instance, on the laundry direction tag).

### Lost and Found:

4-H Alberta is not responsible for lost items or items left behind at the end of the sessions. We strongly urge you to label your clothing and belongings, and check the Lost and Found ("Dobby's Socks") for any items your child may have left behind. Items will be held at the 4-H Centre, or the regional offices (for the regional camps) for 3 weeks after the end of each session, and then donated to local charities. We do not have the capacity to hold onto unclaimed items after three weeks.
